

METROPOLITAN BUSHEY BOWLS CLUB LEGITIMATE INTERESTS ASSESSMENT

There are three lawful bases for processing data, one of which must be chosen to comply with the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

- ☐ Consent
- ☐ Necessary for the performance of a contract
- ☐ Legitimate interests

MBBC has chosen to use “Legitimate Interest” and therefore needs to conduct a Legitimate Interest Assessment (LIA). This requires MBBC to identify a legitimate interest, show what processes are necessary to achieve it and balance it against the individual’s interests, rights and freedoms. A copy of this LIA will be kept on record and reviewed annually as part of MBBC’s general policy review. Details of Legitimate Interests must be included in the MBBC’s privacy notice.

Surname and First name	Used to identify the member in communications by post, email, telephone or in person.	Yes. Communication is paramount for the club to function.	Data shared with the Hon. Secretary is shared with other club members and printed in the fixture card. Committee members also have their contact details placed on the website and printed on the fixture card. The fixture card is distributed to club members and Match Secretaries of some clubs.

Postal address	Used by the Hon. Secretary to send information to those members not on email.	As above.	As above
Email	Used by the Hon. Secretary and Hon. Competition Secretary to send information to club members.	As above	As above
Phone numbers	Used by all members to contact other members or provide or request information.	As above	As above
Bowls Club	Used by all members to identify the bowls club that they represent.	As above	As above
Role	Used to identify the role that the data subject performs within the club e.g. Treasurer, President etc.	As above	As above
Health & medical information	Information on health will only be held at the expressed wish of the individual and only shared with the individual's permission.	Optional but beneficial if immediate medical intervention is required for individuals living with life threatening conditions or allergies.	Members on a 'need to know' basis as instructed by the individual.
